### Week 0



**Decubitus Sacral Ulcer** onset: Oct 2005  
 Study Begin: Feb 21, 2006  
 Wound Dimensions: **98 cm<sup>2</sup>**, 2.5 cm depth (VisiTrak®)  
 Dressing applied: SelectSilver™, gauze, ABD pad, Exu-Dry® and tape. Change outer dressings daily at nursing home.  
 Foul odor, Moderate drainage.

### Week 2



Date: March 7, 2006  
 Wound Dimensions: **60.6 cm<sup>2</sup>**, 2.5 cm depth (VisiTrak®)  
 Dressing applied: SelectSilver™, gauze, ABD pad, Hypafix™ and tape. SelectSilver™ dressing changed every other day at nursing home. Change outer dressings more often if needed.  
 No wound odor, Moderate drainage.

### Week 4



Date: March 21, 2006  
 Wound Dimensions: **\*69.8 cm<sup>2</sup>**, 2.0 cm depth (VisiTrak®)  
 Dressing applied: Patient off study. Physician continuing with SelectSilver™, gauze, ABD pad, Hypafix™ and tape due to good progress.  
 No wound odor, Moderate drainage.

### Week 16



Date: June 13, 2006  
 Wound Dimensions: **23 cm<sup>2</sup>**, 2.0 cm depth (VisiTrak®)  
 Dressing applied: Physician continuing with SelectSilver™, gauze, ABD pad, Hypafix™ and tape due to good progress.  
 No wound odor, Moderate drainage.
