

Case Study - Trauma

Week 0



Scrape on arm due to fall - onset: Aug 2005

Wound almost healed in Dec. but deteriorated. Improving in Jan. 2006, but still persists. Improving but still persists in Feb.

Study Begin: March 7, 2006

Wound Dimensions: 8.2 cm², 0 cm depth (VisiTrak[®])

Dressing applied: Mepitel[®], SelectSilver[™], gauze, Kerlix[®].

Leave on for 7 days.

Mild drainage, no pain, no odor, no maceration.

Week 2



Visit Date - March 21, 2006

Wound Dimensions: 0.9 cm², 0 cm depth (VisiTrak[®])

Dressing applied: Mepitel[®], SelectSilver[™], gauze, Kerlix[®].

Leave on for 7 days.

Mild drainage, no pain, no odor, no maceration.

Week 3



Visit Date - March 28, 2006

Wound Dimensions: 0.1 cm², 0.1 cm depth (VisiTrak[®])

Dressing applied: Mepitel[®], SelectSilver[™], gauze, Kerlix[®].

Leave on for 7 days.

Mild drainage, no pain, no odor, no maceration.

Week 5



Visit Date - April 4, 2006

Wound Dimensions: < 0.1 cm², 0 cm depth (VisiTrak[®])

Dressing applied: Mepitel[®], SelectSilver[™], gauze, Kerlix[®].

Leave on for 7 days.

Mild drainage, no pain, no odor, no maceration.

Wound considered healed on April 11.
